#### 3.2 Building & Equipment



Located in the Jubilee Hall, the Pre-School occupies both the John Orme room, which is used as the main Pre-School space for activities, and the Nicholls room, which is divided into two areas. One is used as an additional space for small group activities, quiet activities and the children's pegs. The second room is the office used for administrative duties, and meetings for staff, committee and parents.

The Pre-School also has an outside space with both hard surface and grass play areas. An outside canopy has been erected to conform with the Early Years Foundation Stage requirements. We also use the Jubilee Hall on a regular basis for Music and Movement and PE.

All the equipment we use is of good quality, caters for a full range of activities, and conforms to the Early Years Foundations Stage requirements. It is well maintained and replaced as necessary, with additional equipment bought on a regular basis.

Equipment includes: sand and water trays, clay, playdough, a collage table, painting and drawing materials, home corner, puppet theatre, shop, café, office, dressing up clothes, small-world toys, construction toys, puzzles and games, climbing frames, outside toys, mud kitchen, sandpit, equipment, parachute, story sacks, books, computer and tablet.

#### PARKING FOR PRE-SCHOOL & USE OF SCHOOL DRIVE

Unless there are extenuating circumstances, it is **NOT** possible to use the school drive or park outside the Pre-School. This is for the safety of all the children. Please use School Lane for drop offs and pick-ups. We do however encourage parents and carers to walk to Pre-School when possible.

**Please, please, please** be considerate and safe when parking. The Highway code clearly states that:

- 1) You must not park near a school entrance.
- 2) You must not park on the yellow zig zags outside the school.
- 3) You must not park opposite or within the 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction except in an authorised parking space. This includes the junction of Stable Lane and School Lane. Parking on the corner severely limits the visibility of both pedestrians and drivers at the junction.

If you happen to be parked outside Pre-School, particularly in the afternoon, you will need to wait until the older children are out of school and have left the area before attempting to reverse/drive out.

If parking is essential, please **REVERSE** into parking spaces. As drivers we must all appreciate how hard it is to see toddlers when reversing and they are around cars.
